

Parent Statement for Partner Services

1. Welcome to our Partner Service

YMCA Childcare, 53 Aungier St, Dublin 2, is a Partner Service, working together with the Department of Children, Equality, Disability, Integration and Youth, and parents to deliver high quality, affordable, inclusive Early Learning and Care (ELC) and/or School Age Childcare (SAC) services for children. As part of that partnership, this statement outlines some of the important things you can expect from us, a Partner Service.

1.1 About Us

Here are some of the basic things to know about us:

A typical week for us is **08:00** to **17:30** Monday to Friday for **51** weeks per year.

At **YMCA Childcare** we offer the following services to children and their families:

Sessional pre-school under the ECCE (Free Pre-school)
Full day care/part time care for Early Learning & Care (ELC)
Term Time School Age Childcare
Out of term School Age Childcare

2. Early Childhood Care and Education Programme (ECCE), Access and Inclusion Model (AIM) and National Childcare Scheme (NCS).

This Partner Service is in contract to deliver the:

National Childcare Scheme (NCS)
Early Childhood Care and Education (ECCE) programme
Community Childcare Subvention Scheme Plus (CCSP)

Early Childhood Care and Education Programme (ECCE):

ECCE provides for 15 hours per week of preschool provision over 38 weeks per year before children start primary school at no charge to parents.

YMCA Childcare will support you in registering your child for the ECCE programme in our service if your child meets the eligibility criteria. Further information about ECCE is available here - <https://www.gov.ie/en/publication/2459ee-early-childhood-care-and-education-programme-ecce/>

Access and Inclusion Model (AIM):

The goal of AIM is to create a more inclusive environment in pre-schools, so all children, regardless of ability, can benefit from quality early learning and care. The model achieves this by providing universal supports to pre-school settings, and targeted supports, which focus on the needs of the individual child, without requiring a diagnosis of disability.

National Childcare Scheme (NCS)

NCS provides subsidies to parents to offset the costs of ELC and SAC. There are three types of NCS subsidies which are all available for children up to the age of 15.

YMCA Childcare will support you in applying for support under the NCS for your family.

3. Fees Policies

As a Partner Service, we operate a Fees Policy that is transparent and understandable to all of our parents, the objective of which is to prevent any and all misunderstandings where possible. Please do not hesitate to contact **Russell Wilbourne, Childcare Manager** who will provide additional clarification as required.

3.1 As a Partner Service, we are committed to operating the 'fee freeze' for Programme Year 2022/2023. This means that we will not charge our parents more for the same service than what we were charging in September 2021.

3.2 Donations - We will not request or accept any donations, voluntary or otherwise from parents/guardians, in respect of the ELC/SAC services being provided.

3.3 Deposits - We will not charge any non-refundable deposits to parents/guardians in the respect of their ELC/SAC service where the parent/guardian takes up the service for which the deposit was paid.

3.4 In order that you can understand what this fee freeze means for you, we have outlined our fees and associated fees policy below.

This Fees Policy will be published widely.

3.5.1 Our Fees Policy applicable on September 30th 2021 was as follows:

ECCE Contract Only Fee Policy

Here at **YMCA Childcare** we offer the ECCE programme to all eligible children. ECCE is free to all eligible children.

Note: Discounts and Refundable Deposit and Booking Fee only apply to full time care.

Section C - Other Additional Information

1. The service closes for one week over the Christmas period and families are charged for this week.
2. If a child is absent or on holidays, families are still charged.
3. Refund policy - Depending on bank processing times, it can take up to 6 weeks for refunds to be confirmed and processed.
4. A refundable deposit is required upfront to secure a child's space. The space is not secure until deposit is received.
5. When leaving the service, a notice period of 4 weeks is required in order for the refundable deposit to be returned. Notice must be communicated in writing.
6. A non-refundable booking fee is charged to cover associated admin costs when a child first starts at the service.
7. It is the responsibility of the parents/guardians to ensure CHICK details remain up to date. If a CHICK expires, the full fee will be charged until new CHICK details are received.
8. In line with NCS regulations, if a child does not regularly attend the same number of funding hours they claim from NCS, their funding may be decreased and their fee will increase.
9. Weekly payments are to be received by direct debit. Exceptions may be made under special circumstances.
10. If a child is attending our ECCE only room (9:00-12:00), they also have the option of attending an extra hour per day (9:00-13:00) for an extra fee.
11. Full time care over the summer is offered as an option to children in Afterschool.
12. Families must let the service know by the end of April if the child will not be attending over the summer but their Afterschool space is to be held for the following September, otherwise the space in September is not guaranteed.
13. Children must be collected by 17:30. A late collection fee will be charged for late collection.

14. There are non-term weeks during the ECCE calendar in which ECCE funding is not received. On these weeks, children attending full time who avail of ECCE will be charged the difference which ECCE would normally cover.
15. Optional non-term care during the ECCE calendar is offered to children in our ECCE only room. It is €93 to attend from 9:00 - 13:00. This must be agreed at the start of the ECCE calendar year. If agreed to, it will be charged unless 4 weeks notice is given.
16. ECCE funding does not run during the summer. If a child in our ECCE only room wishes to attend over the summer, confirmation of this must be received in writing by the end of April. Otherwise a summer space can not be guaranteed for them.
